Guest Speaker: John Somes, Danvers YMCA CEO

Today's topic was, Danvers Community YMCA and how the COVID Pandemic has affected membership, fundraising, programs, community involvement and childcare. John discussed a number of topics and how the Y is conforming to change with CDC and Board of Health Guidelines. From offering remote learning for childcare to organizing blood drives—the Y is there to support the community needs. The Y was able to continue to run summer camp programs at both sites and provide needed camperships to those in need. Swimming programs are back up and running at limited capacities. The Y continues to fundraise but with modifications. For example—they were not allowed to organize a golf tourney so they held a Golf Ball Drop instead where 1 person won \$5000. This year the annual dance is being replaced with a online auction. The Cardio Center is open daily but has to run at 40% capacity. Just recently the Y has opened up their Youth Center for Middle School and High School members. John also talked about building updates, sanitizing and cleaning policies. Continue to wear makes, wash your hands, social distant and stay healthy.
