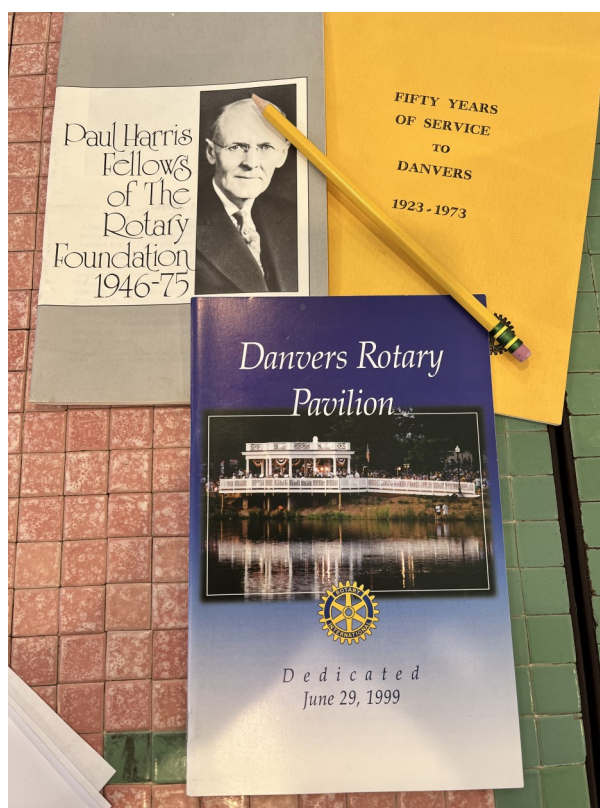
Luncheon
